THE 'RTR' BOUNDARY STONE

Three (3) found 'Boundary Stones', have the letters 'RTR' and 'JCH' + a 'Roman numeral' inscribed in the stone; 'RTR' on the one side and 'JCH' on the opposite side.

I have been duly informed that the boundary stones inscribed with 'RTR', are likely to be that of 'Richard Thomas Roberts' of the 'Roberts' and 'Richards' family of Aberdare, Glamorgan; and my own research confirms that the letters 'JCH' relate to 'John Capel Hanbury' (b.1853 - d.1921) of the 'Hanbury' family of Pontypool, Monmouthshire.

To link both sides of the inscribed boundary stones, I undertook the necessary genealogy research to discover who the person behind 'RTR' really was. I can now confirm that my research has proved successful and after securing both the birth and death dates, 'RTR' does indeed relate to 'Richard Thomas Roberts' (b.1843 – d.1912).

'Richard Thomas Roberts' (b.1843 – d.1912) was also descended from the wealthy 'Richards' family who had owned both property and land across South East Wales. It is believed that 'Maesgwyn Farm' and its land was once owed by the 'Richards' family back in the early nineteenth century. However, they sold it to 'JR Blewitt' of 'Llantarnam Abbey' and the 'Magna Porta Estate' before selling back again to the 'Roberts' family.
